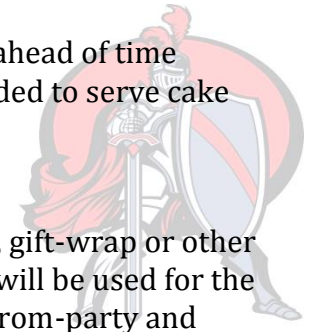

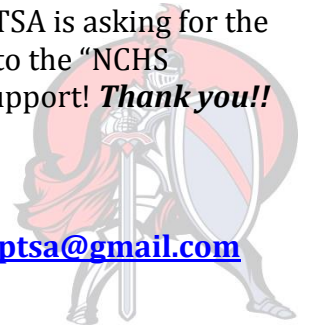

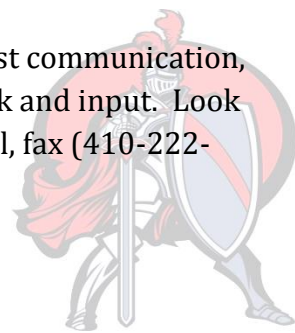
Vision
