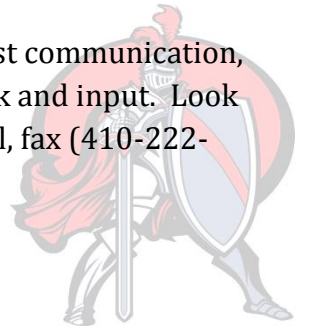
Vision
