1. Complete the online AACC application at www.aacc.edu/admissions.
2. Complete the [Early College Access Program \(ECAP\) form](#) and submit to your guidance counselor for approval (May reduce cost to **\$75**).
3. Complete the [Early College Access Grant \(ECAG\) form](#) and submit to Guidance Counselor (May reduce cost to **0\$**).
4. Submit test scores (SAT READING 510 or ACT ENGLISH 18) **OR** take the AACC Accuplacer assessment on December 7th during 3rd period (Sign up in Guidance).
5. Register for the desired spring class(es) with Bob Latham and Rosalies Toledo during interest sessions held in October (Check with counselor for dates).
6. Registration and payment must be completed by **NOVEMBER 1st**.

Opioid Overdose Response Training

The Anne Arundel County Department of Health's Adult Addiction Program is offering free training and certification to community members on the use of intranasal naloxone to reverse an opioid overdose and prevent death. Once certified, trainees will receive a prescription for a naloxone kit to administer to victims of opioid overdose. The prescription for the kit can be filled at certain local pharmacies.

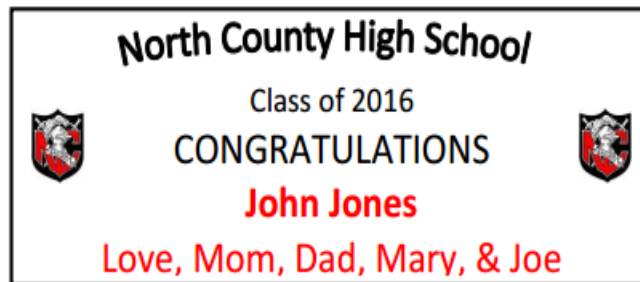
