PARKING PERMITS: Place on Vehicle as Directed by the School

The following Pledge will be read and signed by the student and the parent before a student may drive and park a motor vehicle on school property:

In consideration of the privilege of parking and operating a motor vehicle on school property, I hereby consent to a search of my motor vehicle at any time while it is on school grounds by a school principal or assistant principal upon the determination that a reasonable belief exists to support the necessity of a search. All vehicle searches will be made in the presence of a third party.

I understand fully that I cannot be compelled to permit this procedure, and that if I refuse to allow a search of my motor vehicle the school administration may suspend my privileges to park and operate a motor vehicle on school property for the remainder of the school year or for such other length of time as the school administration shall decide is appropriate.

AACPS Parking Guidelines

Parking spaces are allotted in the following priority order:

(Please indicate if any of these circumstances apply to your application and who is your counselor/sponsor)

- 1) Seniors participating in school-supervised work/intern programs needed to graduate
- 2) Seniors attending Jump Start or another educational pursuit as determined by the principal
- 3) Seniors who are involved in extra-curricular activities.
- 4) Seniors who have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 and above at the time spaces are allotted.

There is a \$15 per semester fee. Students in Priority 1 or 2 for the entire year may be issued a year pass at \$30, all other students receive semester passes at \$15 per semester.

Student Parking Regulations on School Property

- Drivers must adhere to the 10 miles per hour driving speed while on school property
- Students must park in their assigned parking space
- Students must report to school on time – they may not be tardy to their first period
- Students are not allowed to return to their vehicles during their scheduled school day. Be sure to bring all items into school that you will need for your classes.
- Students are not allowed to transport other students off of school property during the school day without administrative and parental written approval.
- Vehicles must display a **current parking permit** on the lower front window of the driver's side.
- Vehicles should be parked facing into the parking space.

Consequences for Violation of Student Parking Regulations

Students in violation of parking procedures can be fined \$15 per infraction, have their cars towed or lose their privileges.

- Student drivers are subject to charges for speeding violations or other infractions which violate driving laws of the State of Maryland.
- Failure to have your parking permit displayed on your car could result in a fine or towing.
- Vehicles parked illegally or without displaying their permit will be towed at the owner's expense.
- Excessive tardiness to school will result in a warning then the lost of parking privileges.
- Students who return to their cars during the regular school day may be subject to search by school administrators or school resource officer and further administrative action if a violation of school policy has occurred.
- Student drivers who take other students off of school grounds without prior written permission will be subject to losing their parking privileges.
